# GED Practice Test Criteria

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It is **suggested** that students meet these criteria before paying to take a GED Ready practice test on [www.ged.com](http://www.ged.com).

Some vouchers are available, allowing students to take the Official Practice Subtests for free. In order for a voucher to be granted, a student **must meet all criteria**.

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- Paid \$10 Material fee
  - Attended 12 hours minimum of instruction
  - Completed pre and post TABE test
  - Scored ABE High Intermediate (506+) or higher on D level of TABE (in any subject: math, reading, or language)
  - Demonstrated or viewed technology tutorial on [www.gedtestingservices.com](http://www.gedtestingservices.com) (see checklist of technology skills needed for GED test)
  - Scored 500 or higher on old version of Math practice test using TX Calculator (if taking the Math GED Ready)
  - Scored 500 or higher on old version Social Studies practice test (if taking Social Studies GED Ready)
  - Scored 500 or higher on old version Science practice test (if taking the Science GED Ready)
  - Scored 500 or higher on old version Reading practice test, got at least 18/25 correct on old version Writing Part 1 test and wrote an acceptable extended response based on writing assessment targets (if taking the Reasoning Through Language Arts GED Ready)
